Bill 1

AN ACT ✓

To Establish a Student Traffic Board

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association  
of the State University of New York College at Oswego:

I. Purpose

This board is established to hear appeals by  
students of summonses received for alleged violations  
of campus parking and traffic regulations.

II. Name

The name of this body shall be the Student Traffic  
Board.

III. Members of the Board

The board shall be composed of five members as follows:

A. Voting members

1. One Presiding Member who shall be a Justice  
of the Supreme Court appointed by the Chief  
Justice with the approval of the President.
2. Two Members who shall be students appointed  
by the President with the approval of the  
Senate.

B. Members without a vote

Both the Dean of Men and the Dean of Women, or  
their authorized representatives shall be members  
of this board but shall not vote under any  
circumstances.

IV. Procedures

The procedures of the Board shall be determined by  
the Supreme Court.

V. Appeal - This board shall have the final jurisdiction  
in student traffic cases.

AN ACT ✓

To establish the resolution form of the State  
University of New York College at Oswego for the  
Student Association Senate

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association of  
the State University of New York College at Oswego:

I. Purpose

This resolution form is the standard form to be  
used at all Senate meetings henceforth for the  
purpose of maintaining procedure for the passing  
of statements of opinion or feeling of the  
Student Senate of the Student Association of the  
State University College at Oswego. It should  
not be construed as an official action of the  
Student Association.

II. Form

The form to be used is that which is given on the  
following page.

III. Modification

This form of resolution may be modified at the  
decision of the Senate to include the enumeration  
of a roll call vote at the end of the resolution.

Be it resolved of the Student Senate of the State

Bill 3

AN ACT

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association of the State University of New York College at Oswego:

- I. Representation of Students to the Faculty-Student Association shall be a matter taken up by the Student Association Senate three weeks prior to the annual meeting.
  - A. Three students, one from each of the upper classes, shall be appointed to serve as Student Representative to the Association, by the President of the Student Association, by and with the consent of the Senate.
  - B. The Senate shall confirm the appointments individually and by a 2/3 vote of all the members present at the meeting.
- II. These representatives may be chosen from among the student Senators, as the post is not to be considered a civil office as defined by the S.A. Constitution.
- III. These representatives shall be empowered to vote, and act on behalf of all of the Students of State University College at Oswego, and truly represent their better interests.
  - A. They shall report to the Senate in writing, and in person, should the Senate desire, concerning the annual meeting of the FSA (Faculty-Student Association) and the general workings of the FSA.
  - B. They shall be subject to recall, should the Senate vote such a motion by a 2/3 vote of all members present at that particular meeting.
- IV. In the event of the disability of any one of these three representatives to perform his duty, the President of the Student Association shall be required to immediately fill the vacancy by appointing another qualified person, by and with the consent of the Senate.

Bill 4

AN ACT ✓

To establish a uniform procedure for Concert Assembly, Festival of the Arts, Sheldon Lecture Series, and College Union Board of Managers to follow if they deem "pay-as-you-go" events necessary to continue to promote high quality programs for the college community.

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association of the State University of New York College at Oswego:

- I. The Concert Assembly, Festival of the Arts, Sheldon Lecture Series and College Union Board of Managers may request supplements to their Student Association subsidy on a "pay-as-you-go" basis under the following provisions:
  - A. The request will be made to the Senate Finance Committee at its regular meeting, or immediately to a special Senate meeting if time does not allow.
  - B. If the request is projected to supplement the activity's subsidy by more than \$100.00 the Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee will present the particulars of the request to the Senate along with that committee's recommendation.
  - C. The Senate will act on the request in the meeting presented.
- II. The following provisions will apply:
  - A. The activity may not enter into a contract which will require monies collected on a pay as you go basis unless it has sufficient funds to cover such an event.
  - B. The maximum amount that an activity may charge for a subsidized event on the pay as you go basis shall not exceed \$2.00.
  - C. An activity may not charge on a pay as you go basis formore than three events each academic year. If there is a double performance by the same performer on the same day, this shall be counted as one event.

- D. Pay-as-you-go monies shall be used to supplement the activities normal subsidy to cover additional expenses necessary for programs of higher than normal costs. (Either of higher quality of appeal or because of more than one performance.)

Bill 5 ✓

AN ACT

To establish a uniform procedure for College Union Board of Managers, Concert Assembly Committee, Sheldon Lecture Series Committee, and Festival of the Arts Committee to follow for "pay-as-you-go" events.

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association of the State University of New York College at Oswego:

The above organizations subsidized by the Student Association may supplement their Student Association subsidy on a "pay-as-you-go" basis according to the following provisions:

- A. The organization may not enter into a contract which will require funds collected on a pay-as-you-go basis unless it has sufficient funds to cover such an event.
- B. The maximum amount an organization may charge for a subsidized event on the pay-as-you-go basis shall not exceed \$1.00.
- C. An organization may not charge on a pay-as-you-go basis for more than three events each academic year. If there is a double performance on the same day, this shall be counted as one event.
- D. The total amount of monies received on a pay-as-you-go basis cannot exceed one-half the total cost of the event.

AN ACT

To authorize a loan of seven thousand dollars (\$7,000.00) to the brothers of Beta Tau Epsilon, Inc. for the construction of a fraternity house.

I. The full amount of the loan will be withdrawn from the Student Association Reserve Fund.

II. Beta Tau Epsilon, Inc. will be responsible for the provision of all necessary legal documents referring to interest, a repayment schedule, and contingencies for lateness of payments.

III. The provisions will be examined by the President of the Student Association and such advisors as he may deem necessary to insure completeness. Any fees incurred for this consultation will be drawn from the Surplus Fund.

Bill 9

AN ACT

To establish criteria for membership on the Concert  
Assembly Committee

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association of  
the State University College at Oswego:

- I. Student Membership
  - A. At least two students from the following
    1. music
    2. drama
    3. dance
  - B. Chairman of Department of the Arts
  - C. Applicants to the Committee, to be appointed by the committee's chairman
  - D. The Chairman of the Concert Assembly Committee shall be elected by Committee's membership at it's first meeting.
- II. Faculty Membership
  - A. Three faculty members, selected by the incoming committee in accordance with the provisions of 11 B. below
  - B. The faculty members shall be selected from the Dean of the College's faculty committee selection list, to serve for a term of three years. The terms of the faculty members shall be rotated, one year apart, to insure continuity. Further, a faculty member may not succeed himself, except after a lapse of one year.
- III. The President of the Student Association and the Coordinator of Cultural Activities shall be ex-officio members of the Committee.
- IV. All Committee members shall share the privilege and responsibility of voting.
- V. Section II A.B. of Bill 7 of the first Legislative Session shall be expunged, after which this section (Section V) shall be expunged.

Bill 10

AN ACT

To indicate, to the Oswego Hospital Building Fund, the intention of the student body of the State University College at Oswego's to participate in the drive, attempting to raise \$5,000.00 prior to January 1, 1970.

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association of the State University College at Oswego:

- I. A letter of intent shall be sent to the Chairman of the Oswego Hospital Building Fund.
  - A. The letter shall indicate our proposed goal for the drive, with an indication as to our schedule for payment.
  - B. The letter shall further indicate that the Student Association will not consider the pledge legally binding, and that the expression of intent may be altered or cancelled at any time by the Senate of the Student Association.
- II. Bill 8 of the First Legislative Session shall be amended as follows:
  - A. Under Section II A. of the bill: Add "5. Coordinate the campus drive for donations to the Oswego Hospital Building Fund. This section shall be expunged at the termination of the hospital drive."
