Introduced by Douglas North

AN ACT

Be it enacted of the Senate of the Student Association of the State University of New York College of Arts and Sciences at Oswego, New York:

That the Residence Hall Recreation Fund, which has in the past been a temporary item on the Faculty-Student Association Budget, shall henceforth be budgeted as a permanent item, and shall be transferred immediately upon availability into the Student Association Budget, the Student Residence Hall Recreation Fund, and not to the Student Affairs Division.

That the said money shall then be distributed to the residence halls under such conditions, restrictions, and procedure as the Senate shall decide.

That the total sum of money transferred be in the amount of \$3.00 per resident student, based on the total number of students capable of being housed in on-campus residence halls (i.e. approximately \$11,655.00 including Oneida).

Be it enacted of the Student Association Senate of the State University College at Oswego that:

No contracts may be signed for the Student Association without the prior approval of the Student Association Senate. These contracts are to be signed by the S.A. President or his designated representative.

Persons signing the Student Association's name to any contract without Senate approval shall be held liable for that contract.

Senate approval of a Budget item will be considered "prior approval". (i.e. If the Senate passes fourteen baseball games per season they need not pass again on who is played (what team) or what date).

AMENDMENT

To the Constitution of the Student Association of the State University of New York College of Arts and Sciences at Oswego, New York.

That, in Article I, Section II, Part 3, the sentence: "The number of Senators shall never exceed 25 nor be less than 15." be deleted.

Note: The above Amendment, in accordance with Article VI of the S.A. Constitution, may by a 2/3 vote of all the members of the Senate be presented to the Student Association. If a majority of all the full-time, regularly enrolled, graduate and undergraduate students of this institution vote to approve this Amendment, it shall be valid for all intents and purposes as part of the S.A. Constitution.
