Whereas it has been recognized that the Department of Finance has evolved and assumed greater responsibility and that the operations and services performed thereunder have encompassed new roles and

Whereas the re-structuring of the Department of Finance is necessary to accommodate the existing functions as well as future changes:

Be it enacted by the Student Association Senate of the State University of New York, College of Arts and Sciences at Oswego that:

~~Bill #3~~ be rescinded and that a Department of Finance and Accounting be established to serve during an interim period while re-organization and an assessment of the functions and objectives of the department are evaluated.

Be it further enacted that the Department of Finance and Accounting operate under the following guidelines:

- I. The chief financial executive of the Student Association shall be known as Director of Finance.
  - a. He shall be appointed by the President with the approval of the Senate.
  - b. His term of office shall coincide with the Student Association fiscal year.
  - c. The responsibilities of his office will include all those as previously outlined in Bill #3 and succeeding legislation.
- II.
  - a. The director of Finance shall be empowered to appoint under him an Assistant Director of Finance and any other assistants as deemed necessary to the operation and control of the Finance and Accounting departments.
  - b. Their powers shall be those described and delegated by the Director of Finance.

Bill 84

Be it enacted by the Student Association Senate of the State University of New York, College of Arts and Sciences at Oswego that:

The Director of Finance for the Student Association, State University College at Oswego, be reimbursed for services rendered during the Fiscal Year ending in July 1972, at the rate of \$5000.00 yearly. This rate is arrived at in consideration of the compounded duties of the obsolete positions of Treasurer and Assistant Treasurer vested in one individual-The Director of Finance- and in consideration of the increased work load that will be incurred during the transitory stage of the Treasury Dept. revamping. The salary is conditional and contingent on the immediate implementation of a vigorous training program that will insure the staffing of the Treasury Dept. on a long term basis. Be it further enacted that \$800.00 be transferred from the surplus in January 1972 to the salary of the Treasurer in the 1971-72 budget in order to bring the salary of the New Director of Finance to the allotted sum of \$5000.00. This salary rate shall be in effect for the fiscal year ending July 1972 only. It shall be subject to review and reconsideration during the preparation of the 1972-73 Budget.

Should the Director of Finance for SA, State University College at Oswego, be appointed prior to Sept. 15, 1971, he should be allotted \$3000.00 for services rendered until July 1972.
