Free Speech Movement be allotted \$150.00 for George E. Smith who gave a lecture in HU on February 14th. Funds are to be allotted from the Program Fund.

Justification:

George E. Smith spent two years as a POW, moving from camp to camp in the middle of the jungle. Impressed from the beginning by Vietcong military proficiency, he slowly overcame his Green Beret "arrogance" and learned to see the VC as people—warm, just, sincere and highly motivated. In 1965 he was released in a gesture honoring Norman Morrison, the Quaker pacifist who immolated himself on the steps of the Pentagon. HE was then held (kind of illegally) by the United States government in Okinawa and threatened--they did not want his story to get out. George has recently had a book published called POW and is on a speaking tour. George Smith is well qualified to present a realistic plan for ending the war and freeing POW's.
