TRAVEL TIP - RENTAL CAR INFO:

(This information is taken from a past Procurement Newsletter .)

It is approximately 50% cheaper to rent a car from the State contracted agency, Enterprise Rent a Car, than to use your personal car and request mileage reimbursement. Austin Travel in the Library basement will make the necessary arrangements so that you have no out of pocket expense. The Library state account will be charged (check with Maryanne or Germaine on the account number).

For rentals for business travel purposes, there is no need to obtain additional insurance as State employees are covered by the State's self-insurance program. If you choose to take out extra insurance you will not be reimbursed.

Also, if renting from a facility off campus, make sure to take along a Tax Exemption Certificate (in Director's Office).

*Enterprise provides free pick up/drop off service from either your home or the University.
