### Institute creates links for global engagement

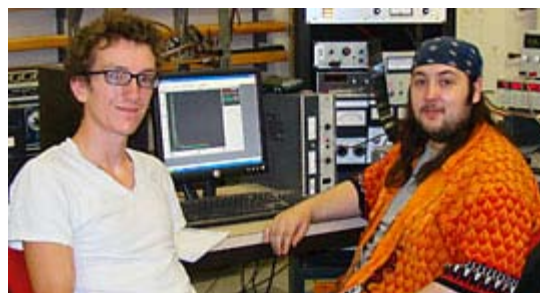
