Registration is now open for the LYC/ Project PATCH Summer Institute, at Long Island's Northport High School. This is a four-day, 30 hour, professional development opportunity for educators of grades K-12. The cost is only \$50 per person. A graduate credit option is also available through Stony Brook University.

The Institute offers 5 separate strands. Participants select the strand that best meets their professional development needs: 1) Character Education and Peer Leadership; 2) Global Issues - International Law and Human Rights; 3) American History Through Constitutional Law; 4) Criminal Justice for Educators; and 5) Mock Trial Leadership and Instruction.
