"The *SUNYConnect* initiative has its roots in the SCLD Annual meeting of 1997 when then Stony Brook Library Director Joseph Branin was asked to produce a plan for the 'SUNY Virtual Library.' The plan called for lobbying for additional state funds to increase access to electronic content, implement a standard library management system with a union catalog and patron initiated borrowing, deploy a delivery system to move items throughout the state, and build regional storage facilities to ease the space constraints in our libraries.

"The degree of success in achieving each of the goals has varied. We have secured some new additional funds from SUNY System Administration, but have not been successful in receiving more money from the State in these difficult budget times. Implementation of Aleph will be complete by the end of 2005, and we are hopeful that the Union Catalog and patron borrowing will be available within the same time frame. The delivery system is in place through a contract with Nylink. We have increased access to electronic resources but not to the extent hoped for, and while we have completed a study indicating our need for storage facilities we have been unsuccessful in acquiring capital funds to build them or operating funds to staff and maintain them.

"Much has changed since 1997 and we need to work together to set the strategic directions for the future of *SUNYConnect* and SUNY Libraries. The *SUNYConnect* Advisory Council will be holding a Planning Retreat in October. Our hope is that the meeting will allow us to enhance our current vision for *SUNYConnect* and SUNY library collaboration that can be presented to library directors at the SCLD Annual Meeting in April of 2005 and to the SUNY Librarians Association in May 2005.

"In order to assist the SAC representatives in their deliberations, we are asking for your vision on the need or desirability for shared library services and facilities over the next several years. Your participation in this request for input on strategic directions for the *SUNYConnect* Advisory Council will significantly aid the development of future planning for shared services and collections within the SUNY community."
