The State University of New York and Elsevier B.V. have reached agreement on new [ScienceDirect](#) licensing. The agreement provides for continuing access to the important research tool: the full-text of approximately 1800 scholarly journals currently publishing, with ongoing access to backfiles of those and approximately 400 other journals.
