Proposed By-laws Amendment

Purpose:

The Committee on Evaluation of Academic Administrators recommends the elimination of the committee on the Utica site. The Committee notes that all academic administrators who might be evaluated by the Committee now have responsibilities on both the Albany and Utica sites, and therefore the tasks previously undertaken by the Committee are more appropriately done by the SUNY-Poly governance structure.

Action:

Upon recommendation of the Committee on Academic Administrators, therefore be it resolved that the By-laws of the Faculty Assembly be altered as follows, with the amendment effective upon ratification by the Faculty Assembly:

To amend Article 5, Section 1 as follows by striking "the Committee on Evaluation of Academic Administrators"

Standing Committees of the Assembly shall consist of the Academic Affairs Committee, the Academic Personnel Committee, the Curriculum Committee, the Planning and Budgeting Committee, the Academic Quality Committee, the Technology Committee, ~~the Committee on Evaluation of Academic Administrators~~, the Graduate Council, and the Distance Learning Committee.

and

To delete Article 5, Section 2d referring to the Committee on Evaluation of Academic Administrators, and renumbering Article 5, Section 2e to Article 5, Section 2d as follows:

~~d. The Committee on Evaluation of Academic Administrators shall be limited to full-time faculty holding tenured or tenure-track appointments.~~

e. d. The Executive Committee shall review, at the end of each academic year, the list of academic units represented on the standing committees (except for Graduate Council and Planning and Budgeting) and make appropriate changes as necessary, to achieve appropriate, balanced representation, and a workable committee size.
