Initial proof videos were submitted for review, and editing of the remaining videos are in process. If unexpected issues arise, we do not expect that they will delay completion significantly.

We expect to be able to complete the project with the remaining available funds. We may need to transfer funds between categories for items like video editing that are proving to be more important to the project success as it progresses.

The most significant roadblock has been an intrinsic mismatch between Coursera design and function and the ability to implement badging in the course. We are now deciding whether to continue to try to find a workaround or to move towards an "on demand" model.
