RE: Student Resolution

I have attached a Resolution 1718-06 from the Student Government at Utica. It consists of three parts: 1 – the petition, 2 – discussion, 3 – signatory endorsements.

The proponents met with me to discuss the reasoning behind the resolution. The resolution states that all courses should be evaluated every time they are offered. They offer it in the spirit of continuous improvement.

As background for you, four of our colleges do evaluate all courses every time they are offered. The remaining two colleges, Arts and Sciences and Engineering do not. There is a statistical threshold below which results are not reported. We have the capability to evaluate all courses every time they are offered at no additional cost.

I understand from Ron, that this Utica Faculty Assembly's Personnel Committee is working on this matter. Since the resolution addresses continuous improvement, it may well be that broader faculty involvement may be appropriate. It may be appropriate to invoke other committees and/or have the students present to governance. Let me know what you wish to do. I am happy to help.
