#### POLICY ON ACADEMIC NEPOTISM

Relatives of faculty and staff members are not to be students in said faculty or staff members' courses without permission of the Vice President for Academic Affairs. Such permission will be granted only if:

1. it is clearly demonstrable that there is no other course selection that will meet the student's academic needs
2. the department chair submits a plan for evaluating the student's work which is clearly and completely separated from any involvement of the related faculty member.

Faculty and staff members are not to be advisors to or enter into other official academic relationships on behalf of the College with student relatives without permission of the Vice President for Academic Affairs. Such permission will be granted only under unusual circumstances in which there is clearly no alternate way to meet the student's program need.
