

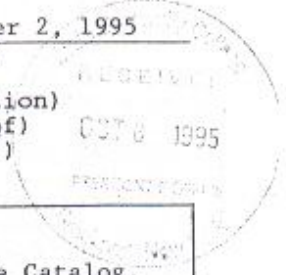

Resolution  
on the  
Inclusion of Professional Staff in the Undergraduate Catalog

WHEREAS the "college catalog" is generally considered to be the primary publication of any institution of higher learning; and

WHEREAS SUNY Brockport's undergraduate catalog, Undergraduate Studies, includes, as do undergraduate catalogs at most other colleges and universities, a roster of all regularly-appointed teaching faculty that includes their rank, their departmental affiliation, their terminal degree and the name of the institution awarding the degree, but no comparable listing for professional employees; and

WHEREAS such an omission not only deprives students and other readers of the catalog of information to which they are entitled, but is an omission that is entirely inconsistent with the spirit of collegiality between teaching faculty and professional staff that has long characterized this institution; therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that the Faculty Senate strongly recommends the inclusion of such a roster of professionals in all future editions of the SUNY Brockport undergraduate catalog.
