If you are not sure what you should do, or if a person refuses to cooperate in identifying himself or herself, retreat to the nearest telephone and call Security for help.

It is hoped that all members of the College community will voluntarily and willingly comply with this policy.

Persons associated with the College should have written permission to remove property from College premises, or proof of ownership, and should cooperate with any College authorities who may question removal of property.
