WHEREAS the College Senate has been engaged in the effort to review faculty responsibilities, roles and rewards, with significant representation and leadership on the Faculty Responsibilities, Roles and Rewards Task Force (FRRRTF); and

WHEREAS the College Senate designated representatives and members have contributed to the drafting, review, and revision of the Faculty Responsibilities, Roles and Rewards Task Force Report (from here referred to as the Report); and

WHEREAS the College Senate leadership has also actively collaborated in the review and analysis of the Report; and

WHEREAS the faculty and staff represented by the College Senate have had many opportunities to provide input during the deliberation process; and

WHEREAS the Report has been developed through an intentionally inclusive process, involving critical self-study, creativity, flexibility, and deliberation extended over the course of two academic years; and
