**Minor change in the Health Science Alcohol/Substance Abuse Studies (HLD) Concentration.**

*Rationale Statement:*

*To allow greater flexibility in student scheduling, the Department wishes to allow students the choice of HLS 409/509 Introduction to Psychoactive Substance Use and Abuse or HLS 418/518 Alcohol Use and Abuse to meet requirements. Both courses provide similar content. This proposal does not modify the HLS 409/509 course content, its objectives, name or any other aspect. HLS 409/509 also serves the HLE (professional) program.*
