**RECOMMENDED FRESHMEN ADMISSIONS CRITERIA
FOR STUDENTS WITH A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA**

I. Scholarship Recipients (New group)

1. Regents program, or a minimum of 17 academic units, including the senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social Studies
 - 3 College preparatory math
 - 3 Science (one with lab)
 - 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. An average of 88 or better and standing in the top 1/4 of the graduating class
3. A minimum SAT of 1100 or ACT of 24

II. Regular Freshmen

1. Regents program, or a minimum of 17 academic units, including the senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social Studies
 - 3 College preparatory math
 - 3 Science (one with lab)
 - 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. An average of 80 or better or standing in the top 1/2 of the graduating class
3. A recommended SAT of 1000 or ACT of 21

III. Transition Freshmen (Summer Program)

1. Regents program, or a minimum of 17 academic units, including the senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social Studies
 - 3 College preparatory math
 - 3 Science (one with lab)
 - 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. An average of 78 [77] or better, or standing in top 3/4 of the graduating class.

3. A recommended SAT of 950 or ACT of 20

IV. Excel

1. Regents program, or a minimum of 17 academic units, including the senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social Studies
 - 3 College preparatory math
 - 3 Science (one with lab)
 - 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. An average of 78 [76] or better. ~~or standing in top 3/4 of the graduating class.~~
3. A recommended SAT of 1100 or ACT of 24

V. Exceptional Talent (Students who have a unique or outstanding qualities in such areas as athletics or the fine arts)

1. Regents program, or a minimum of 17 academic units, including the senior year
 - 4 English
 - 4 Social Studies
 - 3 College preparatory math
 - 3 Science (one with lab)
 - 3 Additional academic courses, which could include foreign language, math, science, English, social studies, fine arts, or technology education
2. An average of 78 [76] or better. ~~or standing in top 3/4 of the graduating class.~~
3. A recommended SAT of 900 or ACT of 19

VI. EOP (For students who do not meet the regular admission criteria, but who do ~~not~~ meet income guidelines set by NYS. A successful pre-admission interview is required.)

1. 14 Academic units, including a minimum one year of college preparatory math
- Course I
2. Average of 76 [74] or above.
3. A minimum of SAT of 700 or ACT of 14 ~~SAT or ACT scores required.~~

**RECOMMENDED ADMISSIONS CRITERIA FOR
TRANSFER STUDENTS**

1. A GPA of 2.25 or higher.
