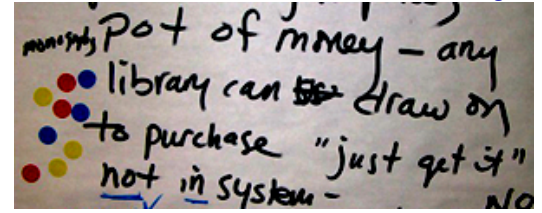


SUNY P.O.D. - Diversifying SUNY Collections Pilot Underway
