

Motion: SUNY Polytechnic Institute, Utica campus policy for emeritus faculty (passed 4/2008, adapted Feb 2015)

Article XV, Title D of the Policies of the Board of Trustees (2014 edition), confers emeritus status upon all faculty who retire in good standing with such privileges as the chief administrative officer of the campus finds feasible. Accordingly, the Faculty Assembly of the Utica campus hereby recommends to the President of SUNY Polytechnic that the following non-financial rights, privileges, and services be available to emeritus faculty:

1. Faculty listing in both the SUNY Polytechnic catalog and SUNY Polytechnic personnel records under Emeritus Professors.
2. Faculty identification card.
3. Access to the SUNY Polytechnic Utica library to include interlibrary loan and database privileges.
4. Access to SUNY Polytechnic Utica recreation facilities.
5. Access to SUNY Polytechnic Utica computer networks, including email, the internet, and file storage.
6. Faculty rights and privileges to attend all SUNY Polytechnic Utica social, cultural, and athletic events.
7. Membership in the credit union.
8. A free parking permit (upon request).
9. The privilege of attending all university-wide faculty meetings, without voting privileges and without committee membership privileges.
10. If space is available, access to office space for the purpose of research.
11. If space is available, access to SUNY Polytechnic Utica labs.

Emeritus status will be conferred automatically upon retirement of eligible faculty as per Board of Trustees policy. Emeritus status shall be terminated 1) at the written request of an emeritus faculty or 2) upon the death of the emeritus faculty.
