The IDA program is intended to assist eligible UUP represented employees both full and part time in developing their professional potential and in preparing for advancement. Funding may be provided for enhancing teaching, research capabilities and improving professional knowledge & skills. The maximum possible award is \$1,000. The program covers eligible projects/activities occurring between July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2011 with a deadline of Wednesday, February 16, 2011. Only one application per project/activity will be accepted for each award period.)
