Bill #53

Be it enacted by the Student Association Senate of the State University of New York, College of Arts and Sciences at Oswego that:

- 1) An Off-Campus Housing Board be established for the following purposes:
  - a) To explore the possibilities of establishing a mechanism to receive and act upon complaints concerning "off-campus housing" for students;
  - b) To prepare and up-date a listing of available off-campus housing;
  - c) To prepare reports on the nature, facilities, and condition of off-campus housing for students;
  - d) To examine avenues to lobby for rent control laws in Oswego.
  
- 2) Membership on the Board shall be determined by the following method:
  - a) The Senate shall elect three Senators, of which two will be from among Commuter Senators and one will be an on-campus Senator, by a plurality vote;
  - b) The President of Student Association shall appoint one member;
  - c) The President of the College shall appoint one member;
  - d) The Legal Advisor for Student Association shall be a member of the board.
  - e) One faculty member shall be elected from among the Faculty Senators by the Senate.



The Chairpersons of the following committees shall be ex-officio members (by virtue of their official status as chairperson) of the Senate Rules Committee. These ex-officio members shall have full voting rights and privileges on the committee.

1. Finance
2. Judiciary
3. Student Affairs
4. Academic Affairs
5. Elections

Be it further enacted that the membership of the Rules Committee shall not exceed ten members, excluding the chairman of the Rules Committee.

Bill #58

Be it enacted by the Student Association Senate of the State University of New York, College of Arts and Sciences at Oswego that:

The following amendments be made to section 1 of the By-laws: that "four" be changed to "three", and that item 'C' be eliminated and in its place item 'D' be considered as item 'C'.

"1. A living center shall be defined for the purposes of Senate apportionment to one of three categories as follows: (a) on-campus residence halls, (b) off-campus residence units recognized as residence halls by the college, (fraternity and sorority houses) and (c) commuters (all students not residing in living centers categorized by a,b, or c above). The Senate shall determine each year the grouping of the several living centers for the purposes of apportionment and enumeration of Senators to be elected by those groups of living centers. These by-laws may be amended by a 2/3's vote of all the members of the Senate."

Be it enacted by the Student Association Senate of the State University of New York, College of Arts and Sciences at Oswego that:

The Student Association Senate in conjunction with the Inter-Dormitory Council launch an immediate investigation into the five on-campus dining hall to determine the :

- A. Quality of food being served at said dining halls.
- B. Preparation procedures and if they differ from dining hall to dining hall.

This committee shall be composed of all volunteer students from the Student Association, Inter-Dormitory Council and the student body at large.
