Senate Minutes

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m.

Senators not present were: Sen.Cherson(sub-Miss Lewandowski), Sen.Grasso (sub-Mr. Rombach), Sen.Greenstein(sub-Miss Cambieri), Sen. McCormack(sub-Miss Jackson), Sen.Neveu(sub-Mr.Murphy), Sen.White(sub-Mr.Martin).

Sen. Kronenbitter moved to amend the agenda to include Bill 46 after Bill 58 under Old Business, Legislative Bills. This was seconded by Sen. Harmony and passed by a hand vote. The agenda was then approved by a hand vote.

Sen.Kszystyniak corrected the minutes to read that the new election bill would be submitted at the Senate meeting of Nov.7th. The minutes were then approved by a hand vote.

Executive Report:

Vice-President Mossgarber announced that details of the Programming Commission's outline and structure will be available at the next Senate meeting. Also, committee heads are reminded that lists of bills to be discharged from committee must be submitted to the Rules Committee by 3:30 on Monday.

At this time, Sen.Slote directed the Senate's attention to the Oswegonian of 11/2/72, specifically the "Uhuru Sasa Sneer", p.20. In reference to this, Sen. Slote wished to go on record as being insulted to see a fellow senator slandered without reasonable substantiation. Sen.Slote asked the press secretary to make his complaint known to the Editor of Uhuru Sasa. Sen.Sachi also stated that he denied the implications and intended to reply in his own letter to the Oswegonian.

Old Business:

Bill 62- was introduced by Sen.Gates. Sen.Harmony called the question and Bill 62 carried, by a vote of 23-yes, 7-no, 0-abs.

Sen. Angell then called for special orders of the day to consider at this time the nomination of Leonard Lynch to the Supreme Court. This passed by a hand vote. Sen.O'Shaughnessy moved to approve the nomination. By a vote of 23-yes, 3-no, 5-abs, the nomination was approved.

Bill 58- was introduced by Sen. Kronenbitter and corrected to read "(c) fraternity and sorority houses." Discussion followed, with the President Pro-tempore assuming the chair while the Vice-President stepped down to comment. Bill 58 carried, by a vote of 24-yes, 5-no, 3-abs.

Bill 46- was introduced by Sen.Cherson. Sen.Kronenbitter proposed an amendment to change the word "explanations" to "descriptions" in sec. b. This carried by a vote of 29-yes, 0-no, 2-abs. Mr. Murphy then moved to amend sec.c to read"...announcing the time, day and place of the Senate meetings." This carried, by a vote of 31-yes, 1-no, 0-abs. Sen. Harmony then proposed an amendment to indicate that money necessary for
