Grades earned include "A", "A-", "B+", "B", "B-", "C+", "C", "E," "S," "U" (Unsatisfactory), "I" (Incomplete), or "PR" (In Progress). No credit is awarded for E, U, I, or PR grades.

*This change deletes "C-" as a graduate grade. There is no change to the balance of the information described under Grading System on p. 35.*

If adopted the new grading system will take effect in September 1999.
